### **2021 CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

It is the intention of The King of the Ranges Stockman's Challenge Committee to run a professional and challenging competition appropriate to the high standard of horsemanship demonstrated by the legendary Bung McInnes, who was named "The King of the Ranges"

- 1. Competitors must be experienced, proven and accomplished riders with educated and fit horses capable of undertaking the rugged and trying conditions of mountain riding.
- 2. Open, Restricted Open and Novice competitors must be 18 years of age and over Junior competitors must be 14 -17 years of age as of 23rd September 2021

  NB: Juniors must have parental or legal guardian consent to participate in the Challenge
- 3. It is compulsory for all competitors to have current ambulance cover.

  A copy of the subscription and number must be submitted with the entry form
- 4. Only FULLY completed entry forms will be accepted. Required fees and signed NCRA Waiver must be included.
- 5. Rule Books and Receipt of payments will be forwarded on acceptance of Entries
- 6. All competitors & horses must be available at Rosedale Horse Complex by 5pm Thursday 23rd Sept 2021\*

Registration Thursday 10am–7pm

Courses open for walking Thursday 11am (or as advised)

Riders' Welcome/ & Briefing Thursday 6pm

\*Vet Check Thursday 4–6pm

\*Arrival after 5pm Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> is allowed with the approval of the Challenge Committee

- 7. The Vet's decision as to whether a horse is sufficiently fit to compete in the competition is final and no discussion will be entered into.
  - \*If a horse is 'vetted out' the Competitor will be given the opportunity to present a replacement within 30 minutes
- 8. Each competitor is allowed only one and the same horse for the entire competition.
- 9. Stock-whips must be carried *ready to use*, when competing, except where individual event rules state otherwise. Failure to carry a stock-whip as required will result in penalties (*Refer to Rules*)
- 10. Competitors under 18 years must wear a safety approved helmet\* at all times when mounted. Competitors under 18 years must wear a protective vest for the Cross Country Event. All competitors must wear a protective helmet for the Cross Country It is recommended that all competitors wear a protective vest for the Cross Country Event \*EA Approved Standards ASNZ 3838, ARB HS 2012, ASTM F1163, PAS 015, SNELL E2001, VGI
- 11. Any person found interfering with, impeding or damaging stock, gear or equipment or interfering with or impeding, judging, scoring or other competitors at any time will be subject to disqualification by the Committee.
- 12. Challenge Entry Fee does not includes wristbands for a support person or children over 12yrs.(ref Entry Form)

  Additional discounted wristbands for adults/children over 12yrs must be purchased with Entry Fee
- 13. Due to space restrictions Competitors using electric tape yards will not be allowed to section off large areas.

  All Competitors are required to advise Vehicle/s & Float sizes and number of horses they will have at Rosedale
- 14. The Committee reserves the right to change any event at any time for safety or any other reason
- 15. **King of the Ranges Stockman's Challenge Committee follows strict animal welfare guidelines:**Any act of inhumane treatment or abuse of a horse at any time whilst on the Rosedale Complex or in the vicinity, will not be tolerated and if discovered, the Committee may immediately bar the responsible party and horse from further participation in the event.
- 16. NSW Dept Primary Industries Bio Security Guidelines are followed at this Event. Hendra Virus Vaccination of horses is recommended.
- 17. All competitors enter this Competition at their own risk with NO responsibility accepted by the King of the Ranges Stockman's Challenge Committee for riders, livestock or property.
